SANTA MARGARITA WATER DISTRICT BEHIND THE SCENES AT UPPER CHIQUITA RESERVOIR

The Santa Margarita Water District (SMWD) recently welcomed customers and community members on an exclusive bus tour to the Upper Chiquita Reservoir, offering a rare, behind-the-scenes look at the people, infrastructure, and technology required to deliver high-quality, reliable drinking water every day.

The event provided attendees with a firsthand opportunity to see the scale and complexity of SMWD's operations—something most residents rarely consider when they turn on the tap.

A Guided Experience with SMWD Experts Leading the tour was Kenny Sanatar, Crew Chief of Water Stations/Systems at SMWD, who guided guests through the facility, highlighting the critical role it plays in ensuring local water reliability.

"The primary goal of the tour was to educate our customers on the extensive work and professional dedication required to manage our systems," Sanatar explained. "We wanted them to see the daily effort, expertise, and proactive measures that ensure they are in good hands for critical needs."

On SMWD's infrastructure tours, guests can meet the professionals who keep SMWD's systems running 24/7. From operators to engineers, each team member plays a vital role in ensuring the community always has access to high-quality drinking water and wastewater services.

Sanatar also spoke about how

SMWD collaborates and coordinates with neighboring water districts.

Eric, who attended the Upper Chiquita tour, said he was first introduced to the District when he attended SMWD's Water Festival with his mother at the age of 12. Today, he is in college, completing a degree and multiple certifications in the water industry. He looks forward to starting his career in water.

Customers Armando and Lisa took the opportunity to tour Upper Chiquita as a mid-week date night. They had their photo taken by the reservoir, on top of the hill, overlooking a beautiful panoramic scene as the sun set. They were engaged in the informative presentation and took the opportunity to ask questions, which Sanatar was happy to answer.

A Hidden Giant in South Orange County For many attendees, the most eye-opening part of the tour was the Upper Chiquita Reservoir itself. Tucked into the hills above Rancho Santa Margarita, the facility is often overlooked by drivers on the 241 Toll Road or Oso Parkway—yet it holds a staggering 244 million gallons of water, enough to supply SMWD customers for several weeks during an emergency.

Completed in 2011, Upper Chiquita Reservoir is the largest domestic water reservoir built in South Orange County in nearly 45 years. It was constructed as part of a regional partnership with neighboring cities and districts to provide



long-term reliability in the event of interruptions to imported water supplies.

Reservoir at a Glance
244 million gallons of emergency drinking water storage (750 acre-feet)
17.8 acres of surface area

Provides up to 168,000 families with 200 gallons of water per day for one week

Built as part of the South Orange County Natural Community Conservation Plan, protecting local habitat and species

Sanatar said, "Thousands of people drive past this site every day without realizing it's here. That hidden capacity is what makes it so remarkable—it's our community's safety net."

He continued, "It was fantastic seeing the customers so happy and engaged while visiting our site that afternoon," he said. "Their visible interest really

highlighted why we do all this work—to consistently provide them with high-quality, reliable drinking water."

Guests left with a new appreciation for SMWD's commitment to reliability, sustainability, and innovation. Several attendees shared that they had no idea the scale of planning and effort involved in ensuring water flows to their homes every day without interruption.

MOULIN ROUGE! THE MUSICAL AT SEGERSTROM CENTER FOR THE ARTS

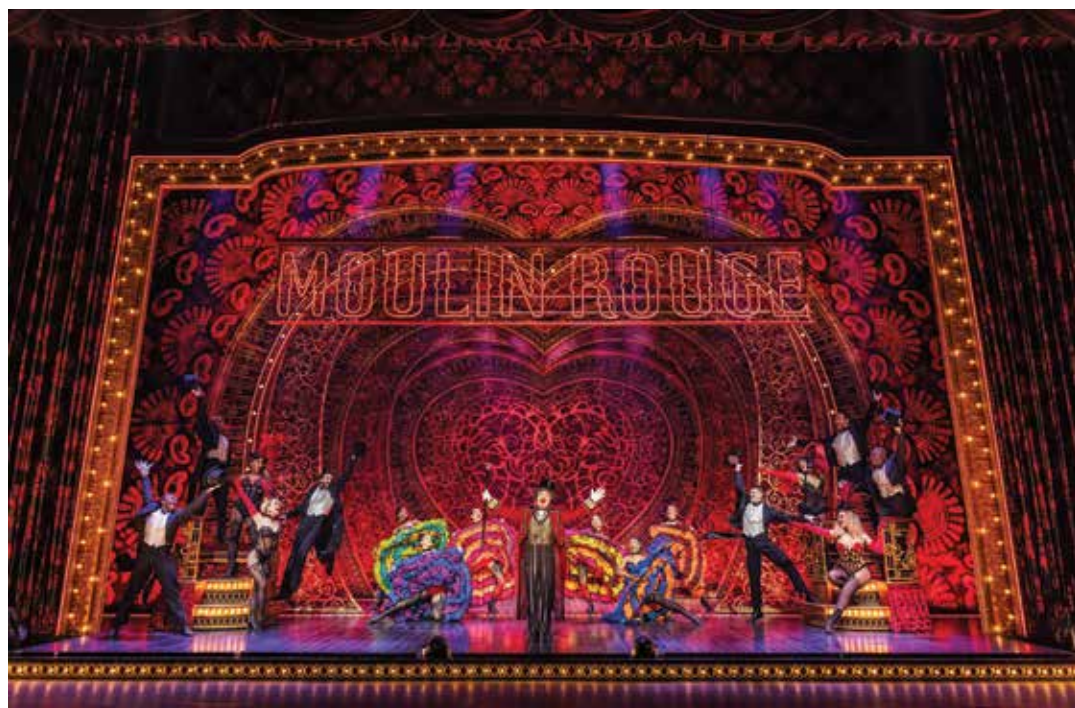

IAN SCHRAGER'S NEW YORK RETREAT IS LISTED FOR \$7.5 MILLION



Native New Yorker and co-founder with his college friend, Steve Rubell, of the Manhattan nightclub, Studio 54, Ian Schrager has been creating beautiful spaces and unique designs for his clubs and hotels since the early 1970s. Working with artists and architects, Schrager followed Studio 54 with Palladium, where he transformed a grand 1920s movie palace into a sensory danceclub working with artists Julian Schnabel, Kenny Scharf, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Keith Haring and Francesco Clemente to make video art a focal point of the club. Ian's focus on art and architecture continued with his hotel creations, including Morgans, Edition, and his most recent project, the New York Public hotel. The Gramercy Park Hotel was renovated under the guidance of Julian Schnabel and features art by Andy Warhol, Fernando Botero, and Cy Twombly. Schrager has a reputation for working with a wide range of talented architects, artists, and designers, including Philippe Starck, Herzog & de Meuron, Andrée Putman, and John Pawson.

Schrager has also put his creative talents into his personal home in Bedford Corners, New York, that he renovated as a family retreat. Located just a few

There are plenty of things to do in and nearby Bedford. In addition to the miles of trails for hiking and biking, Bedford is famous for its historical homes and events. The district has preserved



much of its colonial character with buildings dating back to the 18th century, including the 1787 court house, which has been converted into a museum. The Bedford Playhouse and Clive Davis Arts Center are located in the town's historic movie theater, showing current and classic movies, plays, art exhibits and community events. Visitors can spend an afternoon hiking the highly

recommended Mianus River Gorge Preserve for awesome scenery or, for even more scenery, take a ride in a hot air balloon from Balloons Over Westchester.
